Whether it's lending a hand with practical work around the home or providing transport, our dedicated volunteers give over 130 hours a week to helping others around the District. 
Going the extra mile

Friends Against Scams

HELP has become a 'Friend Against Scams' to help stop people becoming a scam victim.



The criminals trick people with flashy, official looking documents or convincing telephone sales patter, with the aim of persuading them to send an administration fee, pay postal or insurance costs or make a premium rate phone call. Doorstep scams are carried out by bogus callers or rogue traders who call, often uninvited, at people's homes under the guise of legitimate business or trade.
