The Harrogate Easier Living Project (HELP) supports older or vulnerable people and those with a disability to remain independent at home through a range of services delivered by staff and volunteers.

Who do we HELP?

Help at Home supports people who are unable to undertake the practical work themselves, cannot afford to pay a tradesperson or do not have a network of family or friends to support them.

What are our other services?

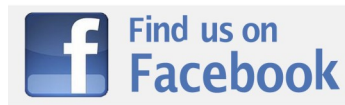

HELP AT HOME

Help at Home is a trusted charitable scheme which has been running since 1996 to help with practical tasks such as:

- ◆ Annual garden tidy *Spring/Summer only
- ◆ Giving walls a fresh lick of paint
- ◆ Basic DIY and small repairs
- ◆ Odd jobs

We can help with anything from moving a bed and changing a lightbulb to clearing out a shed and putting up pictures.

How does it work?

Our work is carried out by a Support Worker alongside volunteers.

All our volunteers are interviewed before they begin with us and references are checked.

How long will I have to wait?

The length of our waiting list varies, however we will get to you as soon as we possibly can. We will call you before we come to ensure that the timing is convenient for you.

How much will it cost?

You would pay for any materials we use. Although we are a charity, we still need to cover our other costs. Before we begin the work we will discuss the amount of your contribution towards these costs depending on the job required and your own personal circumstances.
